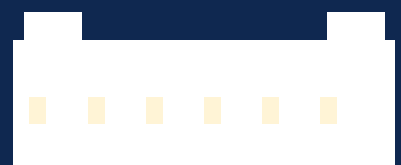

# Palace, zoo, wheel, gelato.

A classic Vienna one-day that keeps curious 4–7 year olds moving

## Schönbrunn Palace gardens

■ Schönbrunner Schlosstraße 47, 1130 Wien

Start outside. Let them run the gravel paths, find the Neptune Fountain, climb the Gloriette hill if energy is high. Skip the palace interior today — too much queuing for this age.

**Parent tip**

Enter via the Hietzing gate — shorter walk to the zoo, fewer tour buses. Bring a snack; the gardens don't allow strollers on the Gloriette steps.

## Tiergarten Schönbrunn — short loop

■ Inside Schönbrunn gardens

World's oldest zoo. Don't try to see it all. Target: pandas, penguin feeding, aquarium tunnel, rainforest house. Loop should take ~90 minutes at kid pace.

**Parent tip**

Penguin feeding is at 11:00 and 14:00. If you can only pick one, 11:00 is less crowded. The zoo's own café is fine; skip the one by the exit.

## Lunch at Landtmann's Jausen Station

■ Inside Schönbrunn park

Kid-friendly Austrian classics — schnitzel with potato, Kaiserschmarrn for dessert. Outdoor seating, changing table, and they're used to stroller parking.

**Parent tip**

Skip the wait — book a table the morning of, 13:00 slot. The kids' schnitzel is plenty; adults can share a portion if you're heading to ice cream later.

## U-Bahn to Prater · quiet time

■ U4 → U1 at Karlsplatz

Two short rides. A blessing: kids sit, you regroup. If your youngest is sleepy, this is their nap window.

**Parent tip**

Buy a 24-hour family ticket — cheaper than singles and covers the return. Prater Hauptallee exit drops you 2 minutes from the playground.

### Prater playgrounds + Riesenrad

■ Prater Hauptallee, 1020 Wien

Start at the playground — 20 minutes of running. Then queue for the Giant Ferris Wheel (Riesenrad) for the city view. Old-timer carousel next door is gentler if the wheel feels too big.

**Parent tip**

Ferris wheel queue peaks at 15:00–16:00. If it's long, do carousel first, wheel at 16:30 when school groups clear out.

### Ice cream at Eis-Greissler

■ Rotenturmstraße 14, 1010 Wien

Austrian dairy, real fruit flavours, zero fuss. The walk from the U-Bahn to the café passes St. Stephen's — a free spire moment.

**Parent tip**

Try 'Goat's milk + raspberry' — sounds weird, tastes like a yogurt-y strawberry. Napkins in the bag; this flavour melts fast.

### Early dinner + wrap-up

■ Figlmüller Lugeck (family-friendly branch)

Share one Wiener Schnitzel — it's the size of the plate. Kids' menu exists but the 'half' option is more interesting. Booking essential.

**Parent tip**

Book 18:30 the night before. Ask for the booth near the back — quieter, and the kids can colour in the menu while you breathe.

## GOOD TO KNOW

# Practical notes before you go.

### ● ENGLISH & GERMAN

All venues on this itinerary have staff who speak English. Menus usually have both.

### ● STROLLER-FRIENDLY

Entire route is step-free except the Gloriette hill. Leave the stroller at the gate.

### ● PUBLIC TRANSPORT

24-hour family ticket (~€13) covers all U-Bahn, tram, bus for two adults + kids.

### ● NAP WINDOWS

Built in at 14:45 U-Bahn transit. If your child naps earlier, swap lunch and palace.

### ● TOILETS

Reliable: zoo entrance, Landtmann café, Prater main square, Figlmüller.

### ● WHAT TO PACK

Water, snacks, a second snack, sunhat, rain shell. Vienna weather turns fast.
